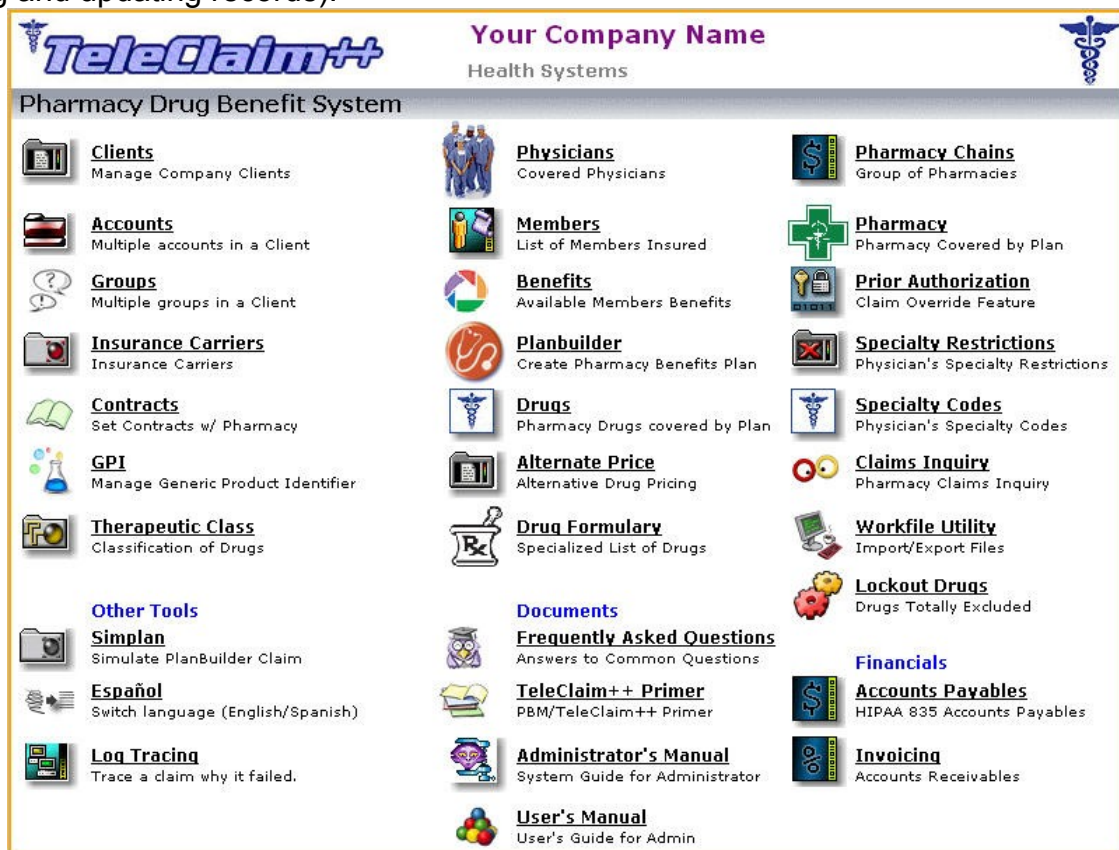


Figure 1. Main Menu
